15th UNDERGRADUATE MEDICAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE 2022



INTRODUCTION:

Undergraduate Medical Research Conference, the face of Peshawar Medical College. An event that is known nationwide for its exemplary work in promoting the research culture among the undergraduate students of the vast field of medical and basic sciences. Not only providing the youth with a strong platform to display their research work but also grooming them to have better skills in communication and social interaction.

Research means knowing more and in-depth about a certain topic.

As **W. Edwards Deming** said "Without data, you are just another person with an opinion" and that is exactly what research helps us with, it provides us with data on which we base our entire hypothesis and get a conclusion that can help cure and benefit billions.

Before the foundation of the Undergraduate Medical Research Conference in Peshawar Medical College was laid research, culture was considered a taboo topic among the undergraduate students of different medical colleges in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa but as soon as it was laid the concept of research became clearer, students were curious and all eyes were on this new innovative idea.

Thus, all in all, this conference has played a very crucial role in solidifying the core essence of research among our undergraduate students giving them the long-awaited boost to turn their ideas into real actions.

This year despite the post-pandemic situation we were able to hold the 15th Undergraduate Medical Research Conference on the 18th-19th of May 2022. The conference was a hit from the start, our team, from the Director UMR to the students and helping staff had worked hard day and night for three consecutive months to make this conference as superlative as possible.

OPENING CEREMONY:

The 15th Undergraduate Medical Research Conference officially began at 9:00 am on 18th May 2022 with our Chief Guest Dr. Adnan Saeed Khan, Director of Nuclear Medicine, Oncology & Radiotherapy Institute (NORI) performing the ribbon-cutting ceremony alongside Dr. Aakifullah Khan, Director IRNUM, Dean of Peshawar Medical College Prof. Dr. Hafeez-Ur-Rehman and numerous



senior professors were also a part of this inauguration ceremony.

As pandemic restrictions were officially lifted, this conference was joined by a huge crowd of not only undergraduate medical students but many postgraduate students, senior doctors, professors, and alumni.

The inauguration progressed smoothly as the chief guests were escorted by the Director and President UMR to the main auditorium hall of Peshawar Medical College where this year's conference was initiated.

PLENARY SESSION - NUCLEAR MEDICINE & MOLECULAR IMAGING:

The plenary session was the first part of this conference. The keynote speaker in the plenary session was **Dr. Aakifullah Khan**, **Director, IRNUM**. In the plenary session, he explained in detail how nuclear medicine was playing a vital role in diagnosing diseases ailing humanity. He further explained how early diagnosing of different diseases related to cancer, cardiology, nephrology, etc., were made easy with the help of molecular imaging and making it possible to get their cures as early as possible.





Moreover, he also applauded the research culture that has been reaching new heights among the undergraduate students.

VIDEOGRAPHY COMPETITION – BRIDGING THE GENERATION GAP:

This year's Videography competition had a very interesting topic "Bridging the Generation Gap", a gap that has always existed between the older and younger generation. This time we asked the students to come up with innovative ideas as to how we can mend the generation gap or make it as invisible as possible.

The responses we got in the form of videos were exceptional and extremely creative. After a very tough, careful judgment and markings first position was taken up by "Amna Khan Khattak & Bibi Mariam for their video – Timeless Connections".





RESEARCH VERBAL PRESENTATION COMPETITION:

This year Research Verbal Presentation Competition was held both in Peshawar Medical and Dental College on both days. The participants of Research Verbal Presentation Competition were divided into different groups based on their area of research i.e. basic sciences, medical education, public health, etc.

The enthusiasm among the young researchers was inspiring and contagious. A panel of highly qualified judges was present to judge the presentations of the students and giving them positive pointers to make further improvements in their future researches. The winners of the competition were announced on the second day of conference in the closing ceremony. A total of 34 applicants had applied for the Verbal Presentation Competition.





RESEARCH POSTER COMPETITION:

One of the most highlighted parts of the undergraduate medical conference was the poster competition. A very important aspect of research is to display it and explain it properly.

The research Poster Competition was also inaugurated by **Dr. Adnan Saeed Khan and Dr. Aakifullah Khan** in the auditorium of Peshawar Medical College. After going through the research posters, they were quite impressed by the uplifted spirits of our young researchers.

A total of **70** Abstracts were received this year for the poster competition from all over Pakistan including most dental and medical colleges alongside a few allied colleges most of which were approved for display. The research posters were also very carefully marked and judged by our very esteemed judges the results of which were announced on the 2nd day of UMR in the closing ceremony.





RESEARCH SKILL STATIONS:

After the introduction of Research Skill Stations in 2019, they have been a very vital part of UMR. These skill stations are specifically designed to educate undergraduate students or anyone in general who is interested in conducting research about the different important steps of conducting research. These stations have been a success year after year.

Our very own talented students of Peshawar Medical and Dental College are properly trained to conduct these Research Skill Stations. This year a huge sum of students joined us in these sessions showing the curiosity of our youth towards research culture.





The research skill stations conducted were:

- 1. Effective literature search
- 2. Study Designs
- 3. Descriptive statistics
- 4. Use of Mendeley for referencing
- 5. The art of presenting your research results: Hands-on use of MS-word and powerpoint.

WORKSHOP:

It was concluded with the team from **Peshawar Medical College** scoring the highest marks and winning the competition.
